We are a very young mission, and we may not have all the answers, but we have a willing heart to learn. This is a new program, and we have big ideas, but we are looking for someone who wants to come down and help create it. Por que no tu is discipleship focused and the main reason for wanting to teach English in the schools is to share the Gospel of Jesus.

We do already have a school program in place that we have been teaching. But your creativity to expand the curriculum would be encouraged.

This is a non-paid position, and you will be responsible for raising you own support. We will work with you to come up with a budget with living cost here in Honduras. But an estimate would be \$2,000 a month. Along with raising support we will ask you to create a prayer team. You will be responsible for writing a email to them every week so they are kept up to date with how you are doing, so they will be able to pray for you better.

This process will begin with you filling out the application. Once we have reviewed your application and received your references questionnaires, you will have an interview with the director in Honduras and the board president. Once accepted, we will ask that you come to Honduras to get a better feel for the place you will be serving and to get to know the team that is already there. Then, once you have raise %100 percent of your budget you will move to Honduras.

The school year runs from February until November, during that time we will ask that you will not return home, unless there is an emergency or during a school break. During their summer you may return home to talk with churches and your support team.

Knowing Spanish is not a prerequisite, but you do have to be willing to learn and to start studying once accepted.
